

# EASTER & GOLF in Tuscany

## DAY 1 - THU

## DAY 4 - SUN

**Mornign:** self-drive to Florence to see the Scoppio del Carro explosion of the cart. A huge, decorated wagon is dragged through Florence by white oxen until it reaches Basilica di Santa Maria del Fiore in Florence's historic centre. Following mass, the Archbishop sends a dove-shaped rocket into the cart, igniting the fireworks held in the cart. This spectacular display is followed by a parade in medieval costumes
